Dear Parents/Guardians of Year 7 pupils

Stoke-on-Trent 0-19 Integrated Health Visiting and School Nursing Service is responsible for your son/daughters health and wellbeing up to the age of 19 years. The change to the secondary school is a good time to remind you of our service and ask you to get in touch if you have any worries or concerns for your child's health.

We are keen to hear if your child has a health condition that needs a care plan, to be sure of their safety and wellbeing during the school day, for conditions such as anaphylaxis (epipen) and epilepsy. We will support you and the school to make sure that your child's care needs are met.

If your child has Asthma the school will ask you to sign a care plan and supply their inhalers for use at school. Your child's school can also write a care plan (and will ask you to sign it) for common health needs such as eczema, mild allergies and migraines.

If you are unsure about your child's immunisations being up to date, then please contact the School Age Immunisation Team on 0808 178 3374 and they can advise if there are any immunisations that have been missed. During your child's time at high school they will be offered their routine "teenage boosters", you will be





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contacted when they are due and they will be given in school. For further information on what's due and when please go to: -
